

Admission Requirements for the Associate Degree Nursing Major

Admission to the AS Nursing major is competitive and limited. Admission is dependent on the number of applications, seat availability, and evidence of meeting the following requirements:

- **Prerequisite courses*:** Must be successfully completed at least ONE WEEK PRIOR to application deadline (classes in progress are not accepted)
 - o Grade of "C" or higher required (C- grades are not accepted)
- **GPA:** A GPA of <u>2.76</u> or above, based on nursing program prerequisite* and corequisite** courses is required
 - o GPA is not an independent criterion for admission
 - o Grades received in Nursing Assistant and CPR courses are not calculated in the nursing GPA

*Prerequisite courses:

- BIOL 2252 Anatomy & Physiology I
- BIOL 2221 Microbiology or BIOL 2254 Anatomy & Physiology II
- o ENGL 1111 College Writing I
- MATH 0092 Algebra Foundations, or appropriate Accuplacer score

**Corequisites:

- BIOL 2254 Anatomy & Physiology II or BIOL 2221 Microbiology
- MATH 1110 College Algebra or MATH 1930 Introduction to Math Sciences*
 - NOTE: Must have necessary prerequisites to take either College Algebra or Intro to Math Sciences in the first semester of the program
- o PSYC 2201 Developmental Psychology
- o CHEM 1100 Introduction to Chemistry
- BIOL 2256 Advanced Physiology
- o PHIL 1201 Ethics or PHIL 2210 Bioethical Issues in Society
- Students on current academic probation or suspension will not be considered for program admission.
- Students with financial holds will not be considered for program admission.
- Students already enrolled in another professional nursing program will not be considered for program admission.
