

## Admission Requirements for the LPN Step-In Major

Admission to the LPN Step-In major is competitive and limited. Admission is dependent on the number of applications, seat availability, and evidence of meeting the following requirements:

- **Prerequisite courses\***: Must be completed by the application deadline
  - Grades of "C" or higher required (C- grades are not accepted)
  - Courses may not be in progress
- **GPA**: A GPA of 2.76 and above, based on program prerequisite\* and corequisite\*\* courses, is required
  - GPA is not an independent criterion for admission
- **LPN Licensure**: LPN licensure must be current and unencumbered

- Students with unpaid balances may not be considered for acceptance or application review
- Students already enrolled in another professional (RN) nursing program will not be considered for acceptance or application review
