

Admission Requirements for the Practical Nursing Diploma Major

Admission to the nursing major is competitive and limited. Admission is dependent on the number of applications, seat availability, and evidence of meeting the following requirements:

- **Pre-requisite courses*:** Must be successfully completed at least ONE WEEK PRIOR to application deadline (courses in progress will not be accepted)
 - o Grade of "C" or higher required (C- grades are not accepted)
- **GPA:** Starting for the fall 2021 PN cohort, a GPA of <u>2.75</u> or above in combined, related general education courses (BIOL 2252, ENGL 1111, BIOL 2254, and PSYC 2201) is required
 - o GPA is not an independent criterion for admission
 - o Grades received in Nursing Assistant and CPR courses are not calculated in the nursing GPA

*Pre-requisite courses:

- o BIOL 2252 Anatomy & Physiology I (3 cr.)
- o ENGL 1111 College Writing I (3 cr.)

Co-requisite courses:

- o BIOL 2254 Anatomy & Physiology II (3 cr.)
- o PSYC 2201 Developmental Psychology (3 cr.)
- Students on current academic probation or suspension will not be considered for program admission
- Students with financial holds will not be considered for program admission
- Students already enrolled in another Practical Nursing program will not be considered for program admission
