

Eligibility & Documentation Requirements

Immunization Requirements:

MUST SUBMIT OFFICIAL DOCUMENTATION TO NTC's ONLINE TRACKING SYSTEM (instructions will be provided).

- > MMR (measles, mumps, rubella)
 - o TWO vaccinations <u>OR</u> antibody blood testing verifying immunity to measles <u>and</u> mumps <u>and</u> rubella
- ➤ Varicella (chicken pox)
 - TWO vaccinations <u>OR</u> antibody blood testing verifying immunity to varicella (history of chicken pox is NOT accepted as verified immunity)
- ➤ **Tdap** (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) One *adult* Tdap vaccination (booster due every 10 years)
- ➤ **Hepatitis B** Three vaccinations, <u>OR</u> antibody blood testing verifying immunity, <u>OR</u> signed declination waiver (request from Nursing Department).
- > Influenza vaccination is required each fall for students participating in clinicals during flu season (mid-fall through spring semester). The Nursing Department will send notification reminders to all students. Vaccination is due by November 1 each fall.
 - Exemptions for medical or religious reasons *only* (clinical policy for wearing of mask applies during flu season). As with vaccination, <u>exemption documentation is required annually by November 1</u>.
- ➤ COVID-19 Two vaccinations (Pfizer or Moderna) OR single vaccination (J & J)
 - o Medical or religious exemptions may be allowed per clinical facility policy
 - o Policy guidelines ongoing

TB (tuberculosis) Screening:

- > Initial, current *Two-step* mantoux* or Quantiferon TB blood testing* must be submitted at program start.
 - o Annually thereafter, single/one-step mantoux or Quantiferon TB blood testing
 - *If mantoux or Quantiferon test shows positive results, or if you have a history of positive reaction to TB skin or blood test, a clear chest x-ray and physician's follow-up assessment/clearance will be required to verify there are no signs of active disease
 - Annually thereafter, physician's follow-up assessment and letter of clearance required. Subsequent x-rays will not be required by the Nursing program; however, please follow the recommendations of your healthcare provider.

Basic Life Support (BLS) HEALTHCARE PROVIDER CPR Certification:

- Must be AHA (American Heart Association) or ARC (American Red Cross) BLS PROVIDER/HEALTHCARE PROVIDER certification. *BE ADVISED*, online-only BLS/CPR or workplace-level courses are NOT ACCEPTED.
 - o Recertification is due every two (2) years.

BACKGROUND CLEARANCE: Two studies are required. Instructions provided at time of program acceptance.
