

LPN Step-In Program Plan of Study

LPN Step-In degree: For a licensed practical nurse, or LPN, who wishes to become a registered nurse, or RN.

The LPN Step-In program is a three-semester Associate of Science degree and is delivered via a hybrid model. Course work is online and asynchronous, so it can be completed any time of day or night – whenever your schedule allows. However, labs and clinicals take place **on campus and in-person** at either Northwest Technical College or one of our local clinical sites, approximately 3-4 consecutive days once per month for the duration of the program.
