DIPLOMA 41 CREDITS

Our 4I-credit Diploma is a one-year program with a fall start that prepares nurses to provide bedside care and interact closely with patients. Graduates are eligible to apply for licensure as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN).

The hybrid delivery model consists of online courses and in-person meetings. Course work online is asynchronous. It can be completed any time of day or night- whenever your schedule allows. Labs and clinicals take place on campus and in-person at either NTC or one of our local clinical sites. **Students can plan to be in person for 2I days per semester.**

STEP I: Students must apply and be admitted to Northwest Technical College

- 1. Apply to Northwest Technical College
- 2. Submit your official high school, GED and/or college transcripts sent directly from the issuing institution to NTC Admissions via mail or by email admissions@ntcmn.edu
 a. International Transcripts must be submitted through ECE or WES.
- **3**. Transfer Students undergo a transfer evaluation process to determine prior course equivalency to those offered at our institution.

STEP 2: Must demonstrate readiness for college-level math and english in the following ways:

MATH 0081 Math Foundations <u>or</u> MATH 0092 Intermediate Algebra, or higher within 5 yrs or Accuplacer score: Advanced Algebraic Functions 240 or higher or High school GPA of 2.6 or above IF the student graduated high school in past 10 yrs or ACT Math score 22 within 5 years or Complete NTC Math Guided Self-Placement Form

ENGL 0100 Read, Reason & Writing, or higher within 5 yrs <u>or</u> Accuplacer score: 250 English/ Reading or higher <u>or</u> High school GPA of 2.6 or above IF the student graduated high school in past 10 yrs <u>or</u> ACT English score 22 within 5 years <u>or</u> Complete NTC English Guided Self-Placement Form

STEP 3: Must complete or enrolled in the following courses, earn a grade of C or higher & meet the prerequisite GPA requirement:

- BIOL 2260 Anatomy & Physiology I 4 credit
- HLTH 1106 Medical Terminology 2 Credit
- PSYC 2201 Developmental Psychology 3 credit
- Prerequisite GPA must be 2.75 or higher when all prerequisites are complete

STEP 4: Must also fulfill the following requirements before they can submit a program application:

- A Certified Nursing Assistant active within 5 years or HLTH 1110: Nursing Assistant
- Active Basic Life Support or HLTH 1410: First Aid/CPR or equivalent
- TEAS score of 53 or higher within 2 years Must be taken at a in-person approved facility

STEP 5: Complete the Practical Nursing Online Application - Separate from the institutional application.

During the designated application window, applicants must complete and submit the Practical Nursing Application online to formally declare their interest in being considered for a specific cohort start.



After completing the prerequisite courses for the Practical Nursing (PN) program, students planning to continue into our LPN Step-In program can take the general courses listed below.

The LPN Step-In program has its own set of prerequisites, and these courses will help you prepare for the application process after finishing the PN program.

Please note: Taking these general courses will not speed up the PN or LPN Step-In programs. However, it can reduce your total credit load once you're enrolled in the LPN Step-In program, making your schedule more manageable.
