By connecting to BSU wireless you are agreeing to abide by the following policies:

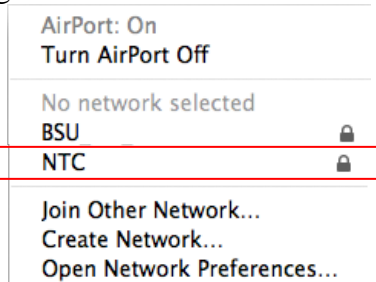

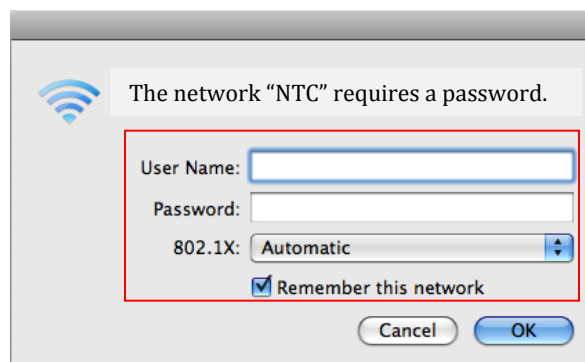

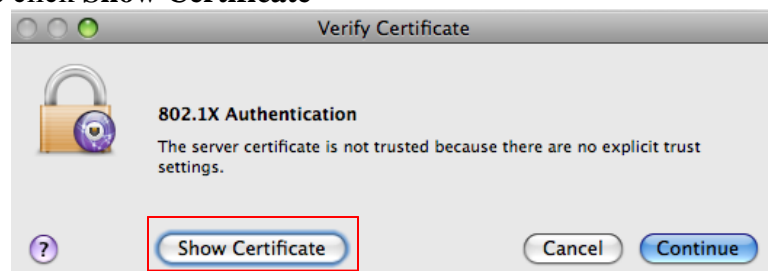
1. Click on the AirPort icon at the top right of the screen and click on NTC



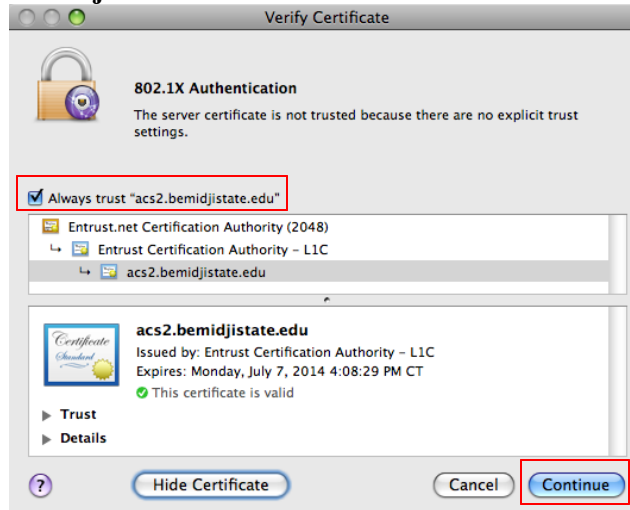
2. You are required to enter your **Directory** (also referred to as Portal/MyNTC/Novel) username and password, then click **OK**. Make sure “**Remember this network**” is checked and leave **802.1x** as **Automatic**.



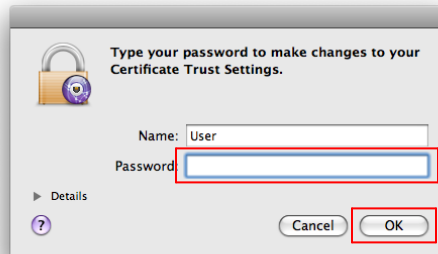
3. At **Verify Certificate** click **Show Certificate**



4. Check **Always trust “acs2.bemidjstate.edu”** and **Continue**



5. Then the “**Type your password to make changes to your Certificate Trust Settings.**” dialog box will pop up. Enter your **COMPUTER** username and password and click **OK**.



6. Then click on the AirPort icon again and choose **Open Network Properties** and click on **Advanced...** bringing up **Airport** dialog box. Click on **802.1X** tab. Click on **WPA: NTC** to highlight it on the left and showing the the information on the right. In the **Authentication** box **UNCHECK** everything **BUT PEAP** and click **OK** to close **Airport** then click **Apply** on Network screen.
