<u>Policy</u>

Entering learners who have taken College Board examinations may receive credit at Northwest Technical College. Credit may be granted for specific courses or electives. Scores must be submitted via official transcript from the College Board to the Admissions Office.

To be recognized for credit, AP scores must be 3 or above; CLEP scores must be 50 or above. IB credit will be individually analyzed. Credits will be awarded pursuant to Minnesota State policy 3.21 and Minnesota Statue 120B.131, Section 16, Subd 3.
