- Please print or type. Complete the form accurately. Misrepresentation of application information is sufficient grounds for canceling admission.
- A one-time \$20 non-refundable application/records fee must be included with your application to EACH institution.** (Some institutions may waive this fee in cases of extreme financial need. Contact the college's or university's Office of Admissions for more information about its policy.)
- Use a separate form to apply for graduate school or international admission at state universities. Call the Office of Admissions where you wish to attend to request the required form.
- Submit this application to the college/university of your choice (see addresses on page 2).
- Official** high school and college transcripts must be submitted to the Office of Admissions of the college or university you wish to attend.
- If you have not already done so, you should apply for financial aid as soon as possible. Many students who qualify for aid do not apply and do not receive funds that may be available for them. Even if you do not qualify for grant aid, submitting a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is required to be eligible for federally guaranteed loans.
