

Health Sciences



Programs

Health Sciences Broad Field provides a strong foundation of coursework needed to specialize in a variety of health and human services programs. Courses include biology, chemistry, anatomy and physiology, psychology, algebra, statistics and other general education courses helpful for acceptance into a baccalaureate program or to pursue an additional associate degree. Graduates can also be qualified for employment as a nursing assistant.

The Health Sciences Broad Field AS is ideal for students who eventually plan to pursue a four-year degree or double major in NTC programs such as nursing, dental assisting or medical office technology. Credits can be transferred to any two or four-year program within the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities system.

Career opportunities

Health Sciences graduates are strong candidates for acceptance into a variety of health and human services programs or employment as a nursing assistant. Graduates with an AS in health sciences are prepared to transfer into baccalaureate programs in nursing,



social work, nutrition, health education and exercise science. Further studies will prepare graduates for a variety of career paths in health and human services, where the demand is high for qualified professionals.



The NTC advantage

NTC Health Sciences Broad Field may be completed online or on campus, including virtual online labs. Online students have access to daytime technical support and online tutorials and training.

NTC students work closely with knowledgeable advisers to explore career plans and baccalaureate programs at Minnesota state universities.

Required courses

Coursework for Health Sciences Broad Field, Associate of Science (AS), includes a broad base of general education with a concentration of 14 technical electives. Credits can be transferred to any two- or four-year program within the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities system.

College readiness courses may be required in reading, writing and math based on performance on the Accuplacer assessment. Contact the Office of Admissions to schedule an assessment.
