Length of Program: 4 semesters

Nursing - Generic track: This 64-credit degree is offered as a two-year program for students with no previous nursing experience. Graduates are eligible to apply for licensure as a registered nurse, or RN.

Admission to the NTC nursing major is competitive and limited. It is dependent on the number of applications and evidence of meeting the following requirements:

- Completed application for admission to Northwest Technical College.
 - Application
 - Application fee
 - High school transcript
 - All college / university transcripts received
- Acceptance to Northwest Technical College.
- Accuplacer assessment completed or waived.
- College-readiness courses completed or waived.
 College-readiness courses: A student may be required to enroll in college-readiness courses in reading, writing, and math. A student's scores on the Accuplacer assessment will determine enrollment in college-readiness courses.
- TEAS exam passed with a score of 64 or higher within the past two years.

If admitted to the Nursing program, the following prerequisite courses must be completed prior to the program start date:

- BIOL 2221: Microbiology
- BIOL 2252: Anatomy & Physiology I
- ENGL 1111: College Writing I
- CNA course completed or currently enrolled
- American Heart Association (AHA) BLS Provider / Healthcare Provider CPR certification.

Prerequisite courses must be completed with grades of C or better prior to fall program start. Courses may be in progress during spring or summer semester preceding fall start.
